- **Plan Commission (1 Board Member, 4-year term)** – interested individuals must be a resident of an unincorporated area of the County, or a resident of the County who is also and owner of real property located in whole or in part in an unincorporated area of the County.
- **Plan Commission (1 Board Member (democrat), 4-year term)** - interested individuals must be a resident of an unincorporated area of the County, or a resident of the County who is also an owner of real property located in whole or in part in an unincorporated area of the County and be a member of the democratic party.
- **White River Fire Protection Board (1 member, 4-year term)** – interested individuals must reside within White River Fire Board District (White River Township) and must has knowledge and experience in matters pertaining to fire protection and related activities in the district.
- **Nineveh Fire Protection Board (1 member, 4-year term)** – interested individuals must reside within Nineveh Fire Protection District (at-large) and must have knowledge and experience in matters pertaining to fire protection and related activities in the district.
- **Hensley Fire Protection Board (1 member, 4-year term)** – interested individuals must reside within Hensley Fire Protection District and Union Township and must have knowledge and experience in matters pertaining to fire protection and related activities in the district.
- **Hensley Fire Protection Board (1 member, 2-year term)** – interested individuals must reside within Hensley Fire Protection District and Hensley Township and must have knowledge and experience in matters pertaining to fire protection and related activities in the district. (current member has moved out of district)
- **Needham Fire Protection Board (1 member, 4-year term)** – interested individuals must reside within Needham Fire Protection District and Needham Township and must have knowledge and experience in matters pertaining to fire protection and related activities in the district.
- **Bargersville Fire Protection Board (1 member, 4-year term)** – interested individuals must reside within Bargersville Fire Protection District (at-large) and must have knowledge and experience in matters pertaining to fire protection and related activities in the district.
- **Bargersville Fire Protection Board (1 member, 4-year term)** – interested individuals must reside within Bargersville Fire Protection District and the Town of Bargersville and must have knowledge and experience in matters pertaining to fire protection and related activities in the district.
- **Drainage Board (1 Board Member, 3-year term)** – interested individuals must be a resident freeholder of the County who are knowledgeable in drainage matters.
- **City of Franklin Buffer Zone Plan Commission (1 Board Member (democrat), 4-year term)** – interested individuals must reside within the City of Franklin Buffer Zone and be a member of the democratic party.
- **Alcohol Beverage Commission Board (1 Board Member, 1 year term)** – interested individuals must be a resident freeholder of the County.
- **Convention, Visitor, and Tourism Board (Board Member(s), 1 and 2-year terms)** – Please list your political party, if you are engaged in the convention, visitor, or tourism business, or involved in promoting conventions, visitors or tourism, and if you are engaged in the business of renting rooms, lodging or accommodations. Interested individuals will also need to include employer’s information.
