

Immunize Your Children

The American Academy of Pediatrics recommends little ones get shots several times during their first couple years of life: 2, 4, 6, 12, 15, and 18 months. The next set of shots is recommended before kindergarten and sixth grade. Flu shots are recommended every year starting at 6 months of age.



Can my child come to the Health Department?

Anyone is welcome to come to the JCHD for immunizations! We accept those who have:

- No insurance
- Hoosier Healthwise
- Insurance that **doesn't** cover vaccines
- Are Alaskan/Native American
- Have private insurance (we currently accept Anthem, Cigna, Encore and Sagamore)

If your child does not meet any of the above criteria, please call the JCHD to inquire about paying out-of-pocket for vaccinations.

Why Immunize?

To prevent disease! "Today, children in the United States can be immunized against 14 diseases. All of these diseases have, at one time or another, been a serious threat to children in this country. Most of them are now at their lowest levels in history, thanks to years of immunizations (Parents' Guide to Childhood Immunizations from the CDC)." Immunizing not only protects your children, but your grandchildren and even their children by keeping the disease under control.



What Should I Expect?

Prior to scheduling an appointment, we would need a copy of the most recent shot record. Once we receive that record, we can schedule an appointment during our clinic hours on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 8:30am-11:00am and 1:00pm-3:30pm.



There is an administration fee of \$20 per child (except for those with Medicaid). A parent or legal guardian must be present for your child to receive vaccinations. You will receive an updated shot record at your appointment, but you may also bring your own record as well for us to update. Please note: Receiving your immunizations at the health department DOES NOT replace getting well-child checks at your physician's office. We look forward to seeing you!

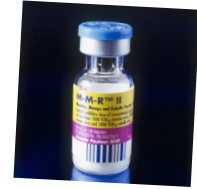
