



- Skin infection
- Sarcoptes scabiei mite
- About 10-15 mites at a time
- Up to 2 million for crusted (Norwegian) scabies
- Microscopic

Life Cycle



Transmission

- Spread before symptoms
- Very contagious
- Direct contact
 - Skin-to-skin
- Indirect contact
 - Linens
 - Furniture
- Not spread by pets

Symptoms

Appear 2-8 weeks first infection
Appear 1-4 days if infected before



Higher Risk for Norwegian Scabies:





- Living or working in crowded places with frequent skin-to-skin contact
- Household or sexual contacts



Diagnosis





Medical Treatment

- Treat all household and close contacts at same time
- Antibiotics for infections
- Usually return to school/work 24 hours after treatment
 - May need retreatment

Environmental Treatment

- Same time as medical treatment
- Hot wash and hot dry
- Dry clean other items
 - wild How to Diagnose Scables

- Seal items in plastic bags
- Vacuum everything
- Do not fumigate



Prevention

- Avoid contact with scabies
- Get treatment if at risk
- Environmental cleaning

- Use personal protective equipment
- Isolate infected individuals
