

Job Requirements

Minimum of High School Diploma or Equivalent



Ability to work evenings and some weekends

Ability to meet all hiring requirements, including criminal background check, DCS background check and passage of a drug screen



Ability to effectively communicate orally and in writing with coworkers, program personnel, participants, official from various governmental and social service agencies, families employers and members of the general public.

Ability to deal swiftly, rationally, and decisively with potentially violent individuals in precarious situations, and take authoritative action applying appropriate discretion and common sense.



Organizes, coordinates, supervises and facilitates prevention, diversion, intervention and re-entry programs for At-Risk and Court Ordered youth and their families.

Acts as liaison to a variety of individuals and agencies receiving and making referrals, explaining program services, integrating policies, procedures and services, verifying participant attendance at school/employment/services, collecting and sharing resources and resolving problems.

Maintain participant files both written and electronically to communicate all contacts and interactions with participant, parent/guardian, and other agencies.

Implement and adhere to Evidence Based
Practices and Program models.

Speak, present and instruct before small and large groups of people.

Meet with families referred by schools, probation and/or court.
