If the non-relocating parent fails to file a written objection, the relocating individual who has custody of the minor child may relocate to the new residence; and

(b) The non-relocating person may also file a petition to modify the present custody, parenting time, or grandparent visitation order; and

(c) The non-relocating party may file a petition requesting an order to prevent the temporary or permanent relocation of the child.

8. All existing orders for custody, parenting time, grandparent visitation and child support remain in effect until modified by the Court.
