## Program Qualifications

- Other than dishonorable discharge
- Served active duty
- DD214
- Proof of homelessness (eviction or shelter letter)
- Picture ID
- Social security card
- Proof of monthly income
- Leasing information

## Client Responsibilities

- Be an active participant
- Complete an initial intake
- Collaborate with Case Manager
- Participate in scheduling office and home visits as needed

## Financial Services

- Deposits (security/utility)
- Rental assistance
- Utility assistance
