

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Notice is hereby given that Johnson County, Indiana, acting by and through its Board of Commissioners, will receive sealed bids at the Office of the Auditor in Johnson County Courthouse West Annex, 86 West Court Street, Franklin, for the Johnson County Sheriff's Office – Crisis Intervention Team Addition Project. Bids are due no later than 10:00 a.m. (local time) on April 24, 2023. Bids received after this time will be returned unopened. E-mailed or faxed bids will not be accepted.

Specifications, Instruction to Bidders, and Bid Forms may be obtained by contacting Wes Harrison, County Project Manager, at wharrison@lhb-eng.com or (317) 431-3863.

Bid security in the amount of 2% of the bid amount, including alternates, must accompany each bid in accordance with the Instruction to Bidders. Bid Security shall be in the form of a bid bond, cashier's check, or certified check which shall be payable to the Board of Commissioners of Johnson County, Indiana.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish performance and payment bonds for one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price prior to the execution of contracts.

The Commissioners reserve the right to accept or reject any bid and to waive any irregularities in bidding. All bids may be held for period not to exceed one hundred twenty (120) days before awarding contracts.

A pre-bid meeting will be held at the lobby of The Johnson County Sheriff's Office at 10a.m. on April 11, 2023, to provide an opportunity for visual inspection and clarification regarding the Project Specifications. Bidder attendance is **mandatory**.

This contract is subject to Federal Award compliance. An awarded written contract must include or incorporate by reference the provisions required under 2 C.F.R Section § 200.326 and as provided for under 2 C.F.R. Part 200, Appendix II applicable under the American Rescue Plan Act. All bidders must comply with all state and federal contract regulations In addition to anti-discrimination policies and in the interest in providing competitive and transparent contract opportunities to a board, diverse network of suppliers in the Johnson County Area, the County is committed to contract with Disadvantaged, Women, and Minority Business Enterprises where feasible. In that spirit, a successful bidder also agrees in good faith to promote the participation of Disadvantaged, Women, and Minority Business Enterprises, as both prime contractors and subcontractors within their bid where available and practical.
